Motion made by D. Lawrence to accept the minutes as amended, seconded by E. Bagley. The motion passed with all in favor.

Presentations/Consultations:

Brad Jones – Byrne Development (Standard Item 1)

- B. Jones The property is located on Route 28A on the right hand side just before the road to the landfill. There are two proposed wetland crossings which are 650 sq. ft. each for a total of 1300 sq. ft.
- E. Bagley The culvert for lot one where will that be because it is steep?
- B. Jones It will cross Route 28A and go down to near the entrance of Chestnut Cove Road. We have done a drainage study and there will be no increase in flow.
- E. Bagley Has the 3:1 ratio been met? There have been other houses built and the road has washed out three times.
- B. Jones Most of the water is going 2% to the brook and back up. There is also going to be a culvert at the entrance.
- E. Bagley Do you provide for a 25 year or 50 year drainage study?
- B. Jones We will be providing information on a 50 year flood.

Standard Dredge and Fill Applications:

1. Byrne Development LLC Map 15 Lots 17, 17-4 & 17-5 – Provide access to a proposed 13-Lot residential subdivision.

Discussion:

2. Puzzo Rev. Family Trust Map 38 Lot 12/DOT Land – Replace one ice cluster and add one H beam for permanent boatlift.

3. Richard Gemberling Map 80 Lot 1 – Construct a 6'x24' dock along shoreline.

Discussion:

The Commission reviewed the application and feels that the applicant submitted something similar in April 2007. The Commission still feels that this proposal is not navigatable and it still appears to be a deck not a dock.

Motion made by E. Bagley to send comments and denial to NH DES, seconded by D. Lawrence. Motion passed with all in favor.

4. James Curvey Map 21A Lot 25 – Repair existing breakwater and catilevered docking structure with no change in size, location, configuration or construction type as per Rule Wt. 303.04(v). Repair of breakwater consists of resetting dislodged/fallen rock; maintenance dredge a 796 sq. ft. area (30 cu. Yds.) to previously approved depth of 500.32 (see permit #2000-259). Dredge spoils to be placed out of NHDES wetlands Bureau jurisdiction.

Discussion:

The Commission reviewed the application and feels that it meets NH Wetlands Bureau rules and to send a standard letter of no objection to NH DES.

Motion made by R. Burgess to send standard letter of no objection to NH DES, seconded by D. Lawrence. Motion passed with all in favor.

5. James Curvey Map 21A Lot 25 – Repair existing breakwater and catilevered docking structure with no change in size, location, configuration or construction type as per Rule Wt. 303.04(v). Repair of breakwater consists of resetting dislodged/fallen rock; maintenance dredge a 400 sq. ft. area for a total volume of 10 cu. Yds. To provide 3' of water depth adjusted to legal full lake elevation 504.32. Dredge spoils to be placed out of NHDES wetlands Bureau jurisdiction.

Discussion:

The Commission reviewed the application and feels that it meet NH Wetlands Bureau rules and to send a standard letter of no objection to NH DES.

Motion made by R. Burgess to send standard letter of no objection to NH DES, seconded by D. Lawrence. Motion passed with all in favor.
