A unit exceeding a pole height of 50 feet or additional units shall require a Special Exception through the Zoning Board of Adjustment as well as Site Plan Review through the Planning Board". Rationale: The purpose of this amendment is to increase energy efficiency capabilities within all zones of the town.
