The Old Home Week Committee met February 19, 2015 to discuss Alton Old Home Week. The meeting was shortened due to time, and a follow up meeting is scheduled for next **Wednesday, February 25 at 5:30pm** at Town Hall. Duane Hammond invited Scott Miller to attend the meeting and present his product to the Committee. The Committee discussed Miller Amusements and the possibility of including them in Alton Old Home Week. Miller Amusements offers rides, concessions (food) and amusements (games). Go to www.milleramusements.com for a complete list of offerings. Miller Amusements provides everything needed for the event and would pay the Town 15% of the proceeds; 20% if proceeds are \$20,000 or more. The Town and Miller Amusements would split the cost of portable toilets and the dumpster (the costs are deducted from the 15%). Miller Amusements has liability insurance and would name the Town of Alton (and whoever else is involved) as additional insured.

The Committee discussed location options and that Alton Bay parking lot would not work due to the 5K Race finish line, Craft Fair vendors and fireworks logistics. R. Sample contacted Brad Smith at the Alton Bay Christian Conference Center to see if that location may be an option to hold the rides, food and games. Miller Amusements is available August 6, 7, 8, &9 and could set up Monday/Tuesday and be open Thursday- 6-10pm, Friday- 6-10pm, Saturday- 1-10pm and Sunday- 1-6pm. Miller Amusements is a cash business and would also need room for their trucks, trailers and campers and 30 staff.

The Committee will continue with the rest of the 2/19/15 Meeting Agenda items at their next meeting on February 25.
