A. CALL TO ORDER: Motion was made by Chairman Conboy to call the meeting to order at 9:32 am.

C: APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Vice Chairman White made a motion to accept the Minutes of the Regular Meeting of June 24, 2014, Commissioner Glidden seconded the motion. Minutes of the Regular Meeting of June 24, 2014 were accepted as read.

E. SUPERINTENDENTS REPORT: Jones Field pump is running an average of 13 hours per day @ 234,000 gallons per day.

Backflow Preventer Valve Testing Class in Holliston was attended by Charles R. Noyes and Superintendent Williams J. Curtin on 7/22/14 thru 7/25/14.

New Bay Street in the Alton Bay Christian Conference Center will need 600' for piping replaced. Existing pipe is 2" mostly galvanized pipe and will be replaced with 1 1/2" Plastic IP pipe. The new pipe will be installed in the same trench line as the old line using a small bucket to dig it up. Vice Chairman Paul White would like Superintendent Curtin to have a meeting with Brad Smith at the ABCCC to discuss the work to be done. Superintendent Curtin is anticipating scheduling the work for September into October.

Milfoil – Superintendent Curtin spoke to some members of the Milfoil Committee to find out if there was any word on the results of the milfoil treatment. Superintendent Curtin and Mr. Noyes walked the area on 7/16 and Superintendent Curtin checked there again on 7/28 and spoke to Mr. Parker and it appears that using the pellets for treatment seems to have worked well. Test results on the lake water have not been received as yet.

FYI – Huggins Hospital is gathering information to build on the corner of New Durham Road and Range Road and McDonalds is also planning on making changes. Dunkin Donuts will also be making changes to their property.
