# Levey Park Trustees

A meeting of the Levey Park Trustees was held Friday, August 3, 2012 at 9:00 am at the Alton Town Hall. Trustees present were: Nancy Downing and Joanne Shurbert.

The minutes of the June 1st meeting were approved with the following changes: Audubon Society should be Society for the Protection of New Hampshire's Forests and the date of the next meeting should be changed from July 13 to August 3. Joanne will submit the approved copy to the town for filing.

## **Old Business**

\$422.42 has been expended for stone dust to make the current trail to the lookout handicap accessible. The path is a work in progress. The trustees wish to extend thanks to Scott Williams Excavating Co. for their work on the path and helping to move the granite bench to the lookout. The trustees also wish to thank Jonathan Downing for donating his tractor and time to the work on the handicap trail.

Nancy has made several calls to have the dead wood cut in the park. She will continue with her efforts.

The gift of the bench from the Jones family has been installed.

## **New Business**

Joanne will send thank you notes on behalf of the trustees to Mrs. Amy Jones and family for the gift of the bench, and to Scott Williams, the Alton Parks & Recreation Department and Jon Downing for their help with placing the granite bench at the lookout and their work on the handicap trail.

The trustees voted to appropriate \$500 to create a map of the trails, Directory signage and brochure to help attract more visitors to the park.

Nancy will meet with Mr. Dunn about the missing granite post on the property line near the Barr Farm.

It was agreed that a work day in the fall will be scheduled to clean up and maintain the park. Once the date is set, the trustees will post a notice in the local paper, and contact local groups such as the Boy Scouts to solicit some help.

The next meeting will be at the call of the Chair.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 9:15 am.
