- 1. Milfoil Committee Milfoil Herbicide Bid
- D. Gould and K. Troendle, Parks & Recreation Director, approached the table. He stated that the Milfoil Committee put it out to bid last fall. There was one company that came back with a bid. It is the company that has been doing the service for the Town for years. The Committee met an unanimously decided to sent it to the Board of Selectmen for approval.
- R. Shea made a motion to award a 3-year contract to Solitude Lake Management for the Milfoil Management Program in accordance with their proposal dated 12-10-24 and N. Buonopane seconded with all in favor of the motion.

The State of NH has already approved an increase to \$4,000. We are asking for \$3,500. It is now up to the individual towns. This is a petition warrant article and R. Shea seconded with all in favor of the motion.
