- 1) Corey J. Clark, Places Mill Road, M69 L3 –Sunset Lake dam reconstruction project 2023- The Sunset Lake Dam will be re-constructed in the spring, summer and fall of 2024 with expected completion in early winter of 2024. The primary spillway which currently exists will remain. The left and right side abutments will be completely re-constructed to me current Dam safety standards. The gate house and stop-log bay will also be completely re-constructed due to deficiencies and deterioration.
