

Alton Conservation Meeting –11/18/05

Co-Chair E. Bagley called the meeting to order at 4:30pm. E. Bagley stated that this was a workshop to develop a recommendation to the Board of Selectmen regarding proposed construction for Map 56 Lot 45, a portion of the Parkhurst Conservation Easement and that there would be no further public input.

After much discussion of pros and cons of the applicants building application for Map 56 Lot 45 a motion was made: Motion made by J. Gengras and seconded by T. Hoopes: the Alton Conservation Commission finds that the proposed structures and changes to the property are inconsistent with the purposes and restrictions of the Parkhurst Conservation Agreement and Deed. Vote recorded 4 ayes and 1 nay. The motion passed.

Motion made by T. Hoopes and seconded by D. Lawrence that the draft letter written by D. Lawrence is to be sent to the Alton Board of Selectmen as it represents the position of the Alton Conservation Commission. Vote recorded 4 ayes and 1 nay.

Motion to adjourn at 5:30pm made by R. Burgess and seconded by E. Bagley. All in favor with unanimous vote.
