 - a. Ascertaining Department Heads' 2023 Budget Goals/Challenges
 - 1. Fire Dept. (G Maloney)
 - GM reports a proposed 2023 budget of \$1,086,664, an increase
 of 9% over the 2022 budget. This is largely due to the desire to
 add 2 full-time Fire/EMT positions to the roster to keep up with
 incoming calls. This would reduce the need for per-diem
 employees and cause a \$52,000 decrease in part-time wages.
 - 2. Police Dept. (G Maloney)
 - GM reports no significant increases expected for the 2023 budget. There will be some COLA and wages increases but the fuel outlook may not be as severe as initially thought. APD may consider increasing training and career budgets to increase staff retention.
 - 3. Public Works (B Varney)
 - BV advises Budget Committee that the following departments:
 Highway, Grounds and Maintenance, Cemeteries, Solid Waste,
 and Water, are now managed by the Director of Public Works,
 Mr. Scott Kinmond as of Monday, July 18th. BV reports that Mr.
 Kinmond had not yet had his meeting RE 2023 budget with the
 directors of his departments, and he did not have information

at this time. The Budget Committee will wait for his update after his meeting at the end of the month.
